Mary Magdalene was the first person to see the risen Jesus.



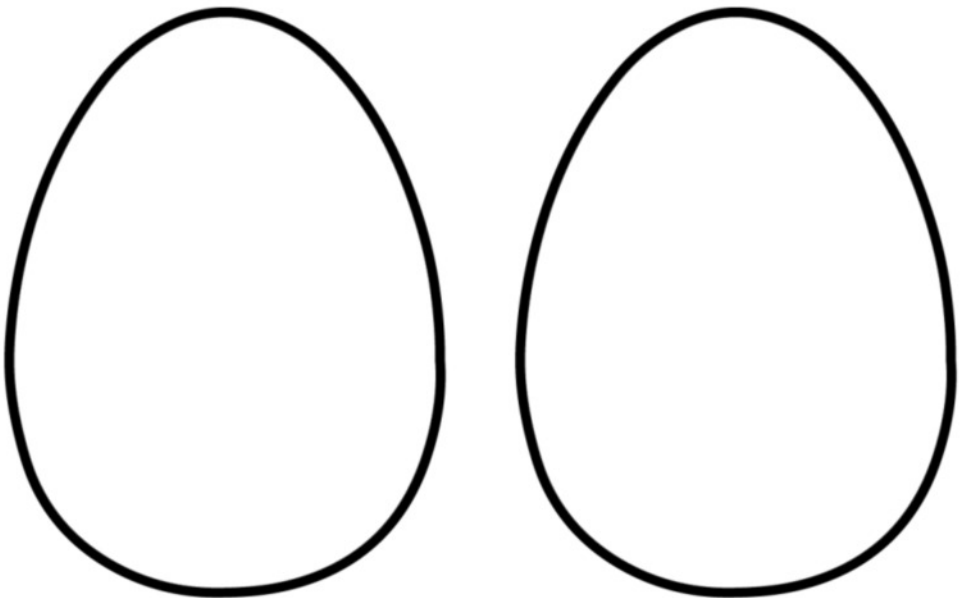
Easter Eggs
